



WEBSITE SELECTION CRITERIA:

Consider the A B C's when using the internet for research...	
AUTHOR	
• Who is the author and what are their credentials?	
• Are they a reputable author or linked to a reputable firm/organisation?	
• Does the site provide additional information on the author?	
• Has the author included a bibliographic list of references? Can the information be verified?	
• URL/domain names – should provide an idea who has published the information i.e. commercial organization, non-profit organization, or government body.	
BIAS	
• Is the information unbiased/authoritative?	
• Is the information fact or opinion and is this clearly stated?	
• Is the information culturally inclusive?	
CURRENT	
• Has the site been recently updated?	
• If appropriate, is the content linked to contemporary practice/ideas/philosophies?	
DESIGN & QUALITY	
• Are you able to navigate the site with ease?	
• Are the images/videos/sound recordings of reasonable quality?	
• Do links work?
